



MAMMEN GLASS & MIRROR, INC. INTRODUCES NEW NAME, NEW PRODUCTS, AND COMPLETED EXPANSION FOR YEAR 51

Irving, TX – December 29, 2006 – Mammen Glass & Mirror, Inc. will begin operating its growing wholesale fabrication business under the name **M³ Glass Technologies**, and will introduce new products to commemorate its 51st year in business.

After 50 years in business, the Mammen family is differentiating its growing wholesale fabrication business with a new name: **M³ Glass Technologies**. Customers will agree that this new name is appropriate, as the Mammens have established their reputation by using the latest technology to bring the highest quality and service to their market. Multiple pieces of CNC equipment were added in 2006 to increase capacity and maintain high levels of customer service.

In the last quarter of 2006, the company completed construction of a 10,000 square foot addition to its main fabrication plant in Irving, Texas. The expansion houses raw glass inventory, enclosed pull-through unloading for trucks, production control and shipping offices, and a new employee break room.

The expansion is also home to M3 Glass Technologies' newest product line: **bent tempered glass**. Installation of the new bending furnace is underway, and will be completed in February. The company chose the Landglass LD-A2436C36 bi-directional furnace, which is capable of producing both flat tempered glass and bent tempered glass up to 96 inches by 144 inches, in thicknesses up to 3/4". This is the company's second Landglass tempering furnace and is the first bi-directional furnace in the USA.

Other products recently added include DecoTherm® digital ceramic frit decoration for glass (www.decotherm.net), heavy Starphire® glass, ShowerGuard™ glass, anti-reflective glass, and one-inch thick glass. More details on the company and its products are available at www.m3glass.com.

"We are excited to start our second 50 years with new space, new equipment, new products, and even a new name," said Chris Mammen, President. "This company has changed immensely since 1956, but we have remained true to our founding principles and God has really blessed us for it."

About M³ Glass Technologies - Mammen Glass was founded in 1956 by J.H. and Lorene Mammen. Today the company is managed by their two sons, John and James Mammen, and by their grandson Chris Mammen. In-house capabilities include CNC glass cutting, beveling, polishing, drilling, routing, and sandblasting. In 2005, Mammen Glass & Mirror became the first independent glass company in north Texas to operate a glass tempering system. Tempering is a heat-strengthening process that turns regular glass into safety glass that shatters into small pieces when broken. Tempered glass is required by code in entrance doors, shower doors, and other hazardous locations. Tempered glass can also be used in other applications where more strength or safety is desired.
